

2010 Counselor-In-Training Program

The CIT program is for current or former Smirkus campers, ages 14 to 18, who possess lots of enthusiasm, responsibility and respect! If you wish to be a role model for campers, assist the counselors in daily tasks and are willing to work hard, then please read on!

Individuals accepted into the CIT program will shadow the counselors throughout the day and assist the program director with afternoon and evening activities. CITs are expected to be great role models for the campers in the dorms, in the tents and during all activities. CITs follow the daily schedule at camp, helping campers to find their shoes and water bottles throughout the day as well as encouraging them to participate in all activities. CITs also aid in the creation, set-up and implementation of non-circus activities at camp. Participants in this program will have the opportunity to help the Program Director create new and exciting activities for both small and large groups of campers. They will also take photographs to post on the Smirkus CIT Blog for camper families and friends to view throughout the summer. While the CITs do not participate in the circus activities with the campers, they will learn various spotting techniques that will allow them to aid the staff with circus training. This program will give participants a “behind the scenes” look at not only what it means to be a counselor, but also what it takes to make Smirkus Camp a safe and fun environment for all of those involved.

There are two Counselor-In-Training positions available in all sessions except for Intermediate and Advanced Camps, for a total of 10 spots. While applicants may indicate which session they would prefer to attend, placement in that session is not guaranteed. There is no tuition fee, however, there is a CIT program charge that covers the cost of meals, lodging, CIT T-shirt and camp photo, as well as an amazing Smirkus Camp experience!
